Colonel Daniel L. Falvey, USAF (retired), 68, of South Bend, IN, died on March 13, 2023, surrounded by his family, after a courageous 4+ year battle against cancer. He was born on April 20, 1954, in Bainbridge, MD, the son of the late Colonel Joseph L. and F. Marcia Falvey (Drake), of Auburn, NY. Dan grew up near several U.S. Air Force bases, the second oldest in a family that grew to four brothers and four sisters.
