Roll call and introductions.

Plaza of Heroes Update (Curt Emery)

Fundraising

Raised about \$850K of the needed \$1M.

Overall participation by classmates is about 30%.

Sqdns 7,13,15,19 and 33 are 50% or better.

7th Sqdn is a 67%!!

Sqdns 29, 30 and 36 are lowest at just above 10%.

We are now in the Landing (last) Phase and need to keep up the pressure to get this done.

Class of '65 who we are sharing costs with is more than 50% participation by their classmates.

Will follow up with email and postcard.

Sgdn reps need to KEEP ASKING!!

Goal is to have maximum participation – donate what you can -- \$100, \$200, \$1000 or more: once you see the completed project you will want to have been a part of it.

Construction

Contractor meeting on 3 Apr.

Reduced cost over-run from 10% to 5%.

Current fundraising allows ground breaking to proceed.

Start date is now 15 May/Completion end of Aug.

Hope to set up a web cam at the construction site to monitor progress.

Items in current shortfall include: 16 AF Cross and 4 Silver Star plaques; Cadet Area replica; Story Boards.

Sijan statue on track (funded by '65)

Dedication

Due to limited seating at Pavilion – we will rent a LARGE tent for overflow (costs split with '65)

And have video relay to tent.

Will invite AFC recipients and will pay for rooms and provide escorts as needed.

CORONA still expected to attend (CSAF, SecAF and Supt).

Planning on a 30-40 minute ceremony.

CO ANG F16 missing man fly-by on track, remain hopeful to get F4 and MiG.

Still need a VOLUNTEER for fly-by activities.

Due to position of tent in the AOG parking lot, expect to shuttle from stadium to AOG on Friday (O'Club parking area is NOT available due to CORONA activities).

Class Memorial (Greg Gillis)

Plan is for Friday early (10'ish?) at the Memorial Wall replica at the AOG (same location as last two reunions).

Will invite widows of classmates via letter and will identify Grad sqdn reps as POC for escort and logistical support. It is expected that widows/family member will pay their own expenses.

Our classmates who are ministers will contribute to the ceremony. Expect to have a bugler and we are looking for a bag piper.

As you may remember the Memorial Wall replica had several issues with the engraving – corrected spelling, non-consistent date format, cracks and fading. This has been contracted to be corrected by the reunion. Our class will split the costs with the AOG (remember this was an earlier '70 class reunion project).

Entertainment (Roger Hill)

Same DJ from last year is booked (Sat night).

AF Band will provide a smaller group to perform a patriotic show.

Merchandise (Mike Torreano)
